

#### **CTE Student Enrollment**

**108,808** total CTE enrollments (**98,470** individual CTE students)

**716** CTE programs across **20** community and technical colleges and the Dept. of Corrections

There were **21,005** postsecondary CTE certificates and associate degrees awarded in the 2023/2024 academic year.

#### Completions

18,151 certificates2,854 associate degrees

an individual's credential completion is only counted once even if they aarned a certificate and degree during the same academic year

## Outcomes

for 2022/2023 postsecondary CTE completers schools were able to contact by follow-up survey

**97%** continued postsecondary education or training, enlisted in the military or were working within a year following credential completion. — Of these students, —

51% are working

50% are enrolled at a community or technical college
11% are enrolled at a four year college/university
31% are in an apprenticeship
1% are in the military
